# Цель урока -

создание средствами английского языка условий для определения учащимися своих личностных качеств и навыков для выявления склонностей к определенной профессии.

# Задачи

**Образовательные**: повторить изученные и изучить новые ЛЕ по темам «Профессии», «Характер человека», активизировать их использование в речи через разные виды речевой деятельности: аудирование, чтение, говорение, обобщить и систематизировать лексические умения и навыки на основе монологических высказываний по теме «Выбор профессии».

**Развивающие:** развивать интеллектуальные способности учащихся; формировать умение выделять главное, сравнивать и анализировать информацию;

**Воспитательные:** научить анализировать свои личностные качества, помочь в определении подходящей профессии.

# Планируемые результаты урока

# Предметные

- обобщение лексического материала по теме «Профессии», его углубление и расширение через разные виды речевой деятельности;
- приобретение дополнительных знаний о профессиях, а именно знакомство с требованиями, содержанием некоторых профессий;

(27%). Maths and English account for 17% and 14% of the total respectively. The least popular option among those polled is "Science", at 11%.

Looking more closely at the pie chart, I can note that the figure for IT is 20% higher than the figure for Science. It can be explained by the fact that nowadays technologies are used in many spheres and IT sphere is becoming more and more in demand, while studying Science does not provide such a wide choice of career opportunities.

**E.A. Klimov identifies five spheres of professional interests:** 





Nature. It includes professions in which a person deals with various phenomena of inanimate and animate nature, e.g. biologist, geographer, geologist, mathematician, physicist, chemist and other professions belonging to the category of natural sciences.

Technology. This group of professions includes various types of labour activity in which a person deals with technology, its use or construction, for example, the profession of engineer, operator, machinist, mechanic, welder, etc.

human. It includes all kinds of professions involving human interaction, e.g. politics, religion, pedagogy, psychology, medicine, commerce, law.

professions concerned with the creation, study and use of various sign systems, e.g. linguistics, mathematical programming languages, methods of graphical representation of the results of observations, etc.

Artistic imagery. This group of professions represents various types of artistic and creative work, e.g. literature, music, theatre, fine arts.
